CUB SCOUT COOK – OFF

Each pack is to hold a cook off between the sixes in their pack, get someone impartial to select the winning six.

District will then hold a cook off between each of the winning sixes from their District and select a winning six.

Branch will then hold a State cook off on 19 June 2010, with more details to follow.

Rules and Requirements.

- Same six and menu must be used at each level of the Cook Off. (no ring in's)
- Same three course menu based on the 5 food groups to include entrée, main and dessert this menu must be used at each level.
- Equipment to be supplied by each group and to be the same equipment at each level. Inc Plates, cutlery, pans, pots and utensils. You can use 1 gas stove and 1 bbq remember safety first.
- Encourage use of table cloths, table decorations and themes.
- Where appropriate group should supply Dining Fly, Esky, Ice, bins and bin bags. All washing up equipment should be supplied by the group, as well as hand washing.
- Aprons, hair appropriately attired and gloves are encouraged.
- Leaders are only able to give guidance not to assist; Cub Scouts must do all the cooking, cleaning and preparation.
- All participants to receive a Have-a-go badge, District Winners to receive a “finalist badge” Winning six to receive a special prize.
- District winner's recipes will be printed into a cook book to be distributed as required.
- Menu must cater for 6 Cubs, one leader and 3 judges.
